To introduce someone, we say:

-This is

-Here is

-He is

-She is

-These are (for two or more persons)

Examples: Mary, this is Peter. He is my cousin.

These are my parents.

Kala: Hi, Ben. I'm fine, thanks.

Ben: This is Tricia. She is from Pointe-Noire.

Kala: Good to meet you, Tricia.

Tricia: Nice to meet you too Kala.

-Happy to see you.

-Glad to meet you.

-Delighted to see you.

-Pleased to meet you.
