2-Accepting an invitation

-I'd love to, thanks.

-That's very kind of you. Thank you for inviting me.

-Sure, I'd love to.

-With pleasure!

-That'd be nice.

-That sounds great / lovely/ super/ fun.

3-Refusing/ declining an invitation

-Sorry, I can't. I have other plans, unfortunately.

-I'm afraid, I can't because ...

-I'd love to, but I can't. I ...

-Thanks for your invitation but ...

Speaking activity
