Yes, or no questions are questions with short answers.

Observe:

Question: **Are** you from Congo?

Answer: **Yes, I am/ No, I'm not.**

Question: **Is** Ann from DRC?

Answer: **Yes, she is/ No, she's not. (No, she isn't)**

Question: **Is** this phone from China?

Answer: **Yes, it is/ No, it's not. (No, it isn't)**

Question: **Are** you and Olivia Gabonese?

Answer: **Yes, we are/ No, we're not. (No, we aren't).**

Question: **Are** they from Pointe-Noire?

Answer: **Yes, they are/ No, they're not. (No, they aren't).**

Exercise one: Make questions using the words between brackets.
