Niveau : Seconde C**1- Introducing oneself / self-introduction**

To introduce oneself, we say:

- My name is (first and family names).
- I'm
- I'm called

Examples: My name is Olivia Okoko.

I'm Ange Mboundou.

Practice: Read the following dialogues aloud.

1. Michel: Hello. My name is Michel Mabiala.

Brice: Hello, Michel. I'm Brice Taty.

Michel: Nice to meet you.

Brice: Pleased to meet you, too.

2. Liz: Good evening. I'm Liz Kaya.

Jos: Good evening, Liz. I'm Jos Madzou.

Liz: How are you?

Jos: Fine, thank you. And you?

Liz: I'm fine, too.

Note: Similar expressions to **Fine, thanks** and **Fine, thank you**.

- Very well, thank you
- Fine.
- I'm well.
- A bit well.

Paul Gabou: Very well, And you?

2- Introducing someone

To introduce someone, we can say:

- This is
- Here is
- He is
- She is
- These are (for two or more persons)



Examples: Olivia, this is Ange BOUNGOU. He is my cousin.
These are my parents.

Read the following dialogue between Mout and Diat aloud

Mout: Hi, Diat. How are you?

Diat: Hi, Mout. I'm fine, thanks.

Mout: This is Bemb. She is from Pointe-Noire.

Diat: Good to meet you, Bemb.

Bemb: Nice to meet you too Diat.

3-Responding to an introduction

To respond to an introduction, we say:

- Nice to meet you.
- Happy to see you.
- Glad to meet you.
- Delighted to see you.
- Pleased to meet you.

Jenny: Good morning, Marion.

Marion: How are you?

Jenny: Fine, thanks. And you?

Marion: I'm fine, too. Jenny, this is Linda. She is my sister.

Linda: Pleased to see you, too.
